I now call for hearing Docket Number E-2,
Sub 1176, which is In the Matter of the Application by
Duke Energy Progress for the -- pursuant to G.S.
62-133.14 and Commission Rule R8-70, for Approval of a
Joint Agency Asset Rider for Recovery of Joint Agency
Asset Costs.

Pursuant to G.S. 62-133.14, on

June 20, 2018, Duke Energy Progress filed its

Application in the above-captioned docket for recovery of costs incurred by DEP for the acquisition and operation of generating capacity acquired by DEP from the North Carolina Eastern Municipal Power Agency in 2015.

Pursuant to Commission Rule R8-70, DEP shall recover such costs by means of a Joint Agency Asset

Rider to be approved annually by this Commission. The JAAR proposed by DEP in this proceeding would be effective for service rendered on or after December 1, 2018, through November 30, 2019.

The Application came to be heard by this

Commission on September 18, 2018, per Scheduling Order

of the Commission in this docket. However, prior to

that hearing, the Commission ordered by Order dated

September 5, 2018, that an additional public hearing

shall be held for purposes of considering certain

late-filed information in the docket.

So that brings us to the purposes of today's hearing which is for the supplemental public hearing.

I now call upon the parties to introduce themselves for the purpose of the record, starting with the Applicant.

MR. SOMERS: Good afternoon. Madam Chair,
Members of the Commission, I'm Bo Somers on behalf of
Duke Energy Progress.

COMMISSIONER MITCHELL: Good afternoon, Mr. Somers.

MS. FENNELL: Good afternoon. I'm Heather Fennell with the Public Staff on behalf of the Using and Consuming Public.

COMMISSIONER MITCHELL: Before we get to the public hearing I will ask you, Mr. Somers, to update the Commission on any additional information about the notices of publication.

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MR. SOMERS: Yes, ma'am. Thank you. All of the notices were published by the papers in the DEP service territory. However, there are two newspapers for which we have not yet received the affidavits but they've confirmed that the notice of this hearing ran; that's the Henderson paper and the Wilmington paper. And I think, as I have advised the Commission in the letter, the Wilmington paper was unable to run the ad in two consecutive weeks because of the impacts of Hurricane Florence. They were able to run the ad a second time but it was just not in two consecutive So at this point we're still waiting for the affidavits from the Henderson and Wilmington papers, but I have been assured that the ads did run.

COMMISSIONER MITCHELL: Okay. Thank you,
Mr. Somers, for that update. And for purposes of
public notice, the Commission finds that with respect
to the notice published in the Wilmington paper that
that second publication is sufficient, even though it
doesn't comply with the two successive weeks that we
