BY THE CHAIR: On May 10, 2019, the Commission issued an Order granting Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP) a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-110.1 and Commission Rule R8-61 to construct the Hot Springs Microgrid Solar and Battery Storage Facility. The Order included a requirement that DEP file a progress report and revisions to DEP's cost estimates (Report) within six months of the issuance of the Order. The due date for the Report was November 12, 2019.

On November 13, 2019, DEP filed a motion requesting an extension of time to November 19, 2019, to file the Report. DEP stated that the extension is necessary due to the press of other business, and that the Public Staff does not object to the requested extension of time.

Based on DEP's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the time for DEP to file the Report to November 19, 2019.
