ORDER ESTABLISHING GENERAL RATE CASE AND SUSPENDING RATES

BY THE COMMISSION: On March 22, 2021, Clarke Utilities, Inc. (Clarke or Applicant) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to increase its rates for water and sewer utility service in all of its service areas in Wake and Franklin Counties, North Carolina. The Applicant serves approximately 358 water customers and 312 sewer customers. The present rates have been in effect since January 1, 2017, pursuant to the Commission's Order issued on December 6, 2016, in Docket Nos. M-100, Sub 138, and W-1205, Sub 8.

The Commission concludes that the application constitutes a general rate case and that the proposed new rates should be suspended pending investigation.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

1. That this proceeding is declared a general rate case pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-137;

2. That the proposed new rates are suspended for up to 270 days pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-134; and.

3. That the Commission shall issue an order establishing discovery guidelines, scheduling hearings, and requiring customer notice at a later date.
