BY THE COMMISSION: This proceeding began with the filing of an application for rate increase by Clarke Utilities, Inc. (Clarke) on March 22, 2021. In an order issued on April 19, 2021, the Commission declared the proceeding to be a general rate case and suspended the proposed new rates for up to 270 days. By order dated May 21, the Commission scheduled a remote customer hearing at 6:30 p.m., on Thursday, June 17, 2021.

On June 11, 2021, the Public Staff filed a Motion to Cancel Hearing. In its motion, the Public Staff stated that the Company had filed the requisite Certificate of Service, which attested that all customers received notice of the rate increase and the hearing, and that no customers submitted a complaint or registered to provide testify at the hearing.
