ORDER GRANTING THIRD
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
COMMENTS

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On November 17, 2020, in response to a motion by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), the Public Staff, and Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (collectively Movants), the Commission issued an Order Granting Second Extension of Time to File Comments in the above-captioned docket. The Order extended to December 4, 2020, the date for the Public Staff, intervenors, and the local distribution natural gas companies (LDCs), to file comments on DEC's revised Residential New Construction (RNC) Program.

On December 2, 2020, Movants filed a joint motion requesting that the Commission grant a further extension of time to December 18, 2020. In summary, Movants stated that they have continued their discussions about the RNC Program and have been exchanging information regarding the Program. Further, they stated that they need an additional two weeks to conclude their discussions and to file their comments. Finally, Movants stated that they contacted the other parties to the proceeding and are authorized to represent that the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association does not oppose the request for an extension of time.


