BY THE CHAIRMAN: On January 26, 2018, the Commission issued an Order establishing proceeding to review the Green Source Advantage Program and Rider GSA proposed by Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively Duke). The Order, among other things, requested that parties file reply comments on or before March 16, 2018, regarding the proposed program or responding to initial comments received.

On March 9, 2018, the Public Staff and Duke filed a joint motion for a two-week extension of time for the filing of reply comments. The movants stated that the extension of time is needed due to, among other things, the movants' current involvement in the Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, rate case hearings in Docket No. E-7, Sub 1146, as well as certain other dockets open for the purpose of implementing House Bill 589 (S.L. 2017-192).

Based on the Public Staff and Duke's joint motion and the record herein, the Chairman finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file reply comments to April 6, 2018.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
