BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On February 23, 2021, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), filed an application in the above-captioned docket for approval of cost recovery for DEC's demand-side management and energy efficiency programs pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.9 and Commission Rule R8-69.

On May 10, 2021, North Carolina Justice Center, North Carolina Housing Coalition, and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (collectively NCJC, *et al.*), filed direct testimony of Forest Bradley-Wright.

In response to a motion filed by DEC, the Public Staff, and other parties, the Commission issued an order on May 28, 2021, excusing all witnesses from testifying at the expert witness hearing that was scheduled for June 1, 2021, canceling the hearing, and accepting all prefiled evidence into the record.

On June 4, 2021, NCJC, *et al.*, filed a motion requesting to file corrected testimony of witness Bradley-Wright, and attached the proposed corrected testimony to its motion.

On June 7, 2021, counsel for the Commission sent an email to counsel for all parties requesting that if a party had an objection to NCJC, *et al.*'s motion that said objection be filed on or before June 11, 2021. No party filed an objection.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to accept into evidence the corrected testimony of witness Bradley-Wright as filed by NCJC, *et al.*, on June 4, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
