BY THE CHAIR: On June 14, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Approving Revised Interconnection Standard and Requiring Reports and Testimony, in the above-stated docket directing Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC, (collectively Duke) to host stakeholder meetings on how to address IEEE-1547 in the NC Interconnection Standard, and file a report with the Commission by April 1, 2020 on the stakeholder process. The order also provided parties may file comments on the report by June 1, 2020.

On May 29, 2020, the North Carolina Clean Energy Business Association (NCCEBA) filed a request for a fifteen-day extension of time. While NCCEBA is working diligently to meet the June 1, 2020 deadline, NCCEBA state it needs additional time to finalize their responsive comments. NCCEBA states that Duke, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association, and the Public Staff have indicated that they support NCCEBA's request for the extension of time.

Based on NCCEBA's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant an extension for all parties to file responsive comments to Monday, June 15, 2020.
