BY THE CHAIR: On October 13, 2021, the Governor signed into law House Bill 951 (S.L. 2021-165). Section 5 of the S.L. 2021-165 authorizes the Commission to establish rules by April 11, 2022, for the securitization of costs associated with the early retirement of subcritical coal-fired generating facilities.

The Chair finds good cause to request comments and proposed rules on the securitization of costs associated with the early retirement of subcritical coal-fired generating facilities.

- 1. That Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC, are hereby made parties to this docket without the necessity of filing petitions to intervene.

- 3. That parties may file comments and proposed rules on or before November 22, 2021; and
 - 4. That parties may file reply comments on or before December 20, 2021.
