P R O C E E D I N G S

CHAIRMAN FINLEY: Good afternoon. Let's come on the record, please. My name is Edward Finley and with me are the other seven (sic) Commissioners of the North Carolina Utilities Commission.

I now call for hearing, for the purpose of taking public witness testimony, Docket Number E-22, Sub 558, which is the Application of Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina for Authority to Adjust Its Electric Rates and Charges and Revise the Fuel Factor Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.2 and NCUC Rule R8-55.

On August 30, 2018, the Company filed an Application for a change in the fuel component of its electric rates.

On September 7, 2018, the Commission issued its Order Scheduling Hearing, Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice.

Petitions to Intervene have been filed by and granted to Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates and Nucor Steel-Hertford.
