BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On February 23, 2021, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), filed an application in the above-captioned docket for approval of cost recovery for DEC's demand-side management and energy efficiency (DSM/EE), programs.

On September 10, 2021, the Commission issued an Order that, among other things, required DEC to work with the Public Staff to calculate certain revised DSM/EE billing factors, and required DEC to file a proposed Notice to Customers (Notice) by October 10, 2021, explaining the DSM/EE rate changes.

On October 8, 2021, DEC filed a motion requesting that the date for filing the Notice be extended to October 18, 2021. In summary, DEC stated that DEC and the Public Staff are working diligently to calculate the revised billing factors and develop the Notice but require additional time to calculate the revised billing factors. Further, DEC stated that it contacted counsel for all parties to this docket about its request for an extension, and that no party had advised DEC that it objects.

The Presiding Commissioner, having considered DEC's motion and the record, grants the motion for good cause shown and hereby extends to October 18, 2021, the date for DEC to file the revised billing factors and required Notice.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
