NOW COME Duke Energy Progress, LLC and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively "the Companies") by and through counsel and pursuant to Rules R1-7 and R1-9 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission"), and respectfully request that the Commission enter an order granting a one-day extension of time until February 26, 2021 for the Companies and Cube Yadkin

Generation, LLC ("Complainant") to file lists of cross-examination exhibits and to provide copies of those exhibits to the Commission and the other parties in this proceeding.

The Companies show the Commission the following:

- 1. On May 28, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Scheduling Hearing* and *Establishing Procedural Schedule on Remand*, which established new deadlines for discovery, prefiled testimony, and a hearing in this proceeding.
- 2. On September 1, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Extension to Time to File Testimony* in this proceeding rescheduling the expert witness hearing in this proceeding to begin on January 26, 2021 and establishing deadlines for parties to file direct and rebuttal testimony.
- 3. On November 12, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Second Extension of Time and Continuing Hearing*, which further extended the deadlines for discovery, prefiled testimony, and ordered that the hearing would be rescheduled by further order of the Commission.
- 4. On December 10, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Granting Third Extension of Time and Scheduling Remote Hearing* ("Third Extension Order"), which further extended the deadlines for prefiled testimony, and ordered that the hearing be held remotely on March 3, 2021, with specific deadlines to file lists of exhibits and consents to remote hearing.
- 5. Pursuant to the Third Extension Order, the Companies and Complainant are required to file a list of proposed cross-examination exhibits ("Exhibit List") at the Commission and to provide copies of these proposed exhibits to the other parties and to the Commission via email on February 25, 2021. The Companies are in the process of

preparing the Exhibit List and cross-examination exhibits; however, due to the press of other business, they will be unable to file the Exhibit List and provide copies of the exhibits within the deadline set in the Third Extension Order. Accordingly, the Companies respectfully request one additional day, until February 26, 2021, to file the Exhibit List and provide copies of the exhibits to the other parties and the Commission.

6. Counsel for Complainant has authorized the Companies to state that Complainant does not oppose the requested extension so long as it applies to both the Complainant and the Companies.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission grant an extension until February 26, 2021 for the Companies and Complainant to file a list of cross-examination exhibits in this proceeding and to provide copies of the cross-examination exhibits to each other and the Commission through email and any such further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
