APPLICANT'S PROPOSED ORDER CANCELING HEARING, GRANTING PARTIAL RATE INCREASE, AND REQUIRING CUSTOMER NOTICE

BY THE COMMISSION: On March 22, 2021, Clarke Utilities, Inc. (Applicant), filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to increase its rates for providing water and sewer utility service in all of its service areas in Wake and Franklin Counties, North Carolina. The Applicant serves approximately 558 water customers and 312 sewer customers. The present rates have been in effect since January 1, 2017 based on orders issued in Docket Nos. M-100, Sub 138 and W-1215, Sub 8.

On April 19, 2021, the Commission issued an Order establishing general rate case, suspending rates. On May 19, 2021, the Commission issued an Order scheduling hearings, and requiring customer notice. On May 25, 2021, the Applicant filed the Certificate of Service indicating that customer notice had been given in accordance with the Commission's Order. The Public Staff and the Commission have not received any protests from the Applicant's customers.

On June 17, 2021, the Public Staff filed the Affidavits of Robert Hinton, Financial Analyst. On June 21, 2021, the Public Staff filed the testimony of Gina Casselberry, Utilities Engineer, and Charles A. Akpom, Staff Accountant. On July 6, 2021, the Public Staff and the Applicant filed with the Commission a motion stating that the Applicant had reviewed the Affidavits and testimony that the Public Staff had filed and agreed to the Public Staff's recommended rates. The parties requested that the July 21, 2021, hearing be canceled.

On July 6, 2021, the Public Staff and the Applicant filed a proposed order recommending that the Commission cancel the hearing, approve the Public Staff's recommended rates and require customer notice.

On July 6, 2021, the parties filed a joint proposed order approving the rates as recommended by the Public Staff.

Based upon the foregoing, the verified application, the affidavit of Mr. Hinton, the testimony of Ms. Casselberry and Mr. Akpom and the entire record in this matter the Commission makes the following:

### FINDINGS OF FACT

- The test year established for use in this proceeding is the 12-month period ended December 31, 2019.
- The Applicant's present and proposed rates filed in the application are as follows:

The present rates generate service revenues of \$184,917 for water operations.

The proposed rates generate service revenues of \$25,534 for water operations.

The present rates generate service revenues of \$158,884 for sewer operations.

- The proposed rates generate service revenues of \$199,151 for sewer operations.
- After an investigation and an audit of the Applicant's records, the Public Staff recommended an increase in service revenues of \$222,625 resulting in a total revenue requirement of \$222,436 for water operations and recommended service revenues of \$199,151 for sewer operations.
- On July 6, 2021, the parties filed a motion with the Commission stating the Applicant agreed with the Public Staff's recommended rates.
  - The quality of service provided by the Applicant is adequate.
- Pursuant to G.S. 62-133.1, the operating ratio method is the appropriate method in determining the Applicant's revenue requirement.
- The level of test year operating revenue deductions after all Public Staff adjustments, excluding regulatory fee, and income taxes is \$183,821 for sewer operations.

The level of test your operating revenue deductions after all Public Staff adjustments, excluding regulatory fee, and income taxes is \$203,740 for water operations

- The original cost rate base for use in this proceeding after all of the Public Staff's adjustments is \$184,211; \$72,384 for water operations; \$111,827 for sewer operations.
- A return of 7.00% on operating revenue deductions is reasonable for use in this
  proceeding. The total annual service revenues necessary to allow the Applicant to
  earn the 7.00% return are \$423,223, an increase of \$79,422 for combined
  operations.

The following rates and rate structures, recommended by the Public Staff and accepted by the Applicant will produce the total of \$423,223 in annual revenue necessary to allow the Applicant to earn the 7.00% return:

That the Schedule of Rates, attached as Appendix A, is approved and deemed to be filed with the Commission pursuant to G.S. 62-138. Said Schedule of Rates is authorized to become effective for service rendered on and after the date of this Order.

4. That the Notice to Customers, attached as Appendix B, be mailed with sufficient postage or hand delivered by the Applicant to all customers affected by the new rates no later than 5 days after the date of this Order; and that the Applicant submit to the Commission the attached Certificate of Service properly signed and notarized not later than 10 days after the date of this Order.
