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BY THE CHAIR: On January 5, 2021, Robert Page, Marcus Trathen, and Craig Schauer (Movants), filed Motions for Substitution of Counsel in the above-captioned dockets, pursuant to Commission Rules R1-7 and R1-23, and Rule 1.16(b) of the North Carolina Rules of Professional Conduct. Movants requested that the Commission enter an order allowing Mr. Page to withdraw from serving as the attorney of record for Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc. (CUCA), and that Mr. Trathen and Mr. Schauer be allowed to serve as the attorneys of record for CUCA. Movants stated that the motions were consented to, and at the direction of CUCA, and that they believe that Mr. Page’s withdrawal can be accomplished without resulting in any material adverse effect to the interests of CUCA.

Based on the foregoing and the record in these dockets, the Chair finds that there is justifiable cause to grant the Motions.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Robert Page is allowed to withdraw as counsel for CUCA, and Marcus Trathen and Craig Schauer are substituted as counsel for CUCA in the above-captioned dockets.
