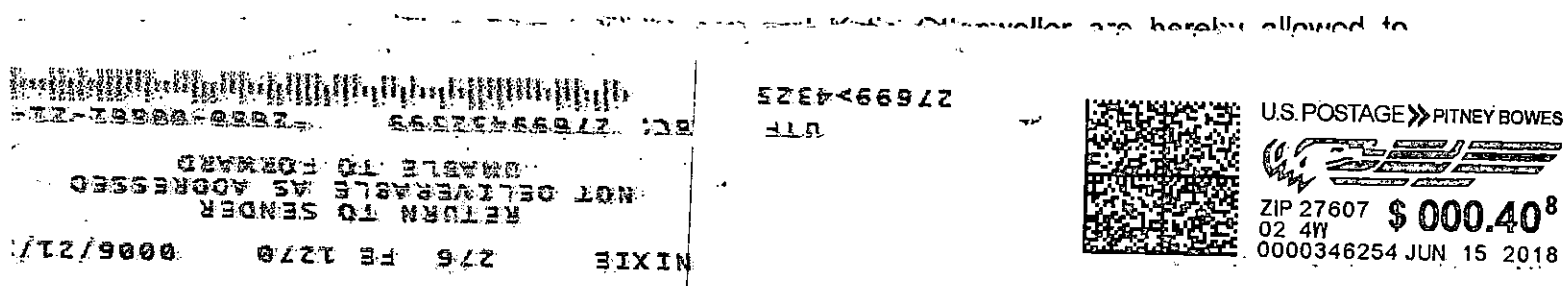

BY THE CHAIRMAN: On April 24, 2018, Gudrun Thompson, Katie Ottenweller and Peter D. Stein (Movants) filed a joint Motion for Withdrawal and Substitution of Counsel for SACE, pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7 and Rule 1.16 of the North Carolina State Bar Rules of Professional Conduct, requesting that the Commission enter an order allowing Ms. Thompson and Ms. Ottenweller to withdraw from serving as the attorneys of record on behalf of the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (SACE) in the above-captioned docket, and substituting Mr. Stein as counsel for SACE.
