NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, the “Companies”), pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7(a)(5) and the *Order Requesting Comments*, issued by the North Carolina Utilities Commission (“Commission”) in these dockets on May 28, 2021, and respectfully move the Commission for an eleven-day extension of time to August 2, 2021 for all parties to file reply comments in the above-captioned dockets. In support of their motion, the Companies show as follows:

1. On April 30, 2021, the Companies filed an application requesting approval of the proposed Make Ready Credit Programs (“MRC Programs”).
2. On May 28, 2021, the Commission issued an order directing parties to file comments and reply comments on the MRC Program. Comments were filed on July 8, 2021 by the following parties: the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission; ChargePoint, Inc.; North Carolina Justice Center and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy; Zeco Systems, Inc. d/b/a Greenlots; Calstarts Coalition for Commercial Electric Vehicles;

North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association; FreeWire Technologies, Inc.; and Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association.

3. The Companies have been working diligently to review the numerous initial comments filed by intervenors and Public Staff on July 8 and believe that a short extension of time would assist all parties to complete their review and address the issues raised in the initial comments.


4. Based on the foregoing, the Companies respectfully request an extension of eleven days, up to and including August 2, 2021, for all parties to file reply comments in these proceedings.

5. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.

6. Counsel for the Companies have contacted counsel for all parties of record regarding this requested extension, and no party has advised that it objects.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order extending the time to August 2, 2021 for all parties to file reply comments, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.


