BY THE COMMISSION: The terms of the following two members of the NC GreenPower (NCGP) Board of Directors expire on September 30, 2018:

Chris Larsen Green Power Technology (Solar/Wind) seat Beth Ritter Consumer/Environmental Advocacy seat

WHEREUPON, the Commission finds good cause to begin accepting nominations to fill these seats on the NCGP Board. Current Board members may be nominated for reappointment by providing the required information by the date due. The Commission remains interested in increasing the racial and gender diversity of the Board and encourages nominations that will promote this effort. Further, it has come to the Commission's attention that the wrong date was stated for the term of three seats in its September 19, 2017 order; and the Commission clarifies that the term expires on September 30, 2020, not 2019, for these three seats currently held by Jamie Applequist, Jeffrey Hughes, and Ward Lenz.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That interested persons may nominate themselves or others to be considered for (re)appointment to the NCGP Board of Directors by providing the following information for each candidate: (a) name and contact information, (b) the Board position sought, and (c) a brief statement of qualifications or résumé. Nominations must be signed and filed with the Office of Chief Clerk of the North Carolina Utilities Commission no later than September 17, 2018; and
- 2. That NCGP shall take reasonable steps to provide notice to interested persons of this opportunity to serve on the Board of Directors and the process adopted herein.
