BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On October 28, 2019, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket extending to November 7, 2019, the date for parties to file briefs and proposed orders herein.

On November 6, 2019, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to November 14, 2019. In support of its motion, DEP stated that it is working diligently to prepare a joint proposed order with the Public Staff, but due to the press of other business DEP needs additional time to prepare the joint proposed order.
