BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 9, 2019, the Commission held a hearing in the above-captioned docket. On September 27, 2019, the transcript was filed in the docket. On October 8, 2019, the Commission issued an Order closing the evidentiary record and confirming that briefs and proposed orders are due to be filed on or before October 28, 2019.

On October 23, 2019, North Carolina Justice Center, North Carolina Housing Coalition, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and the Public Staff (collectively, Movants) filed a motion requesting that the date for filing briefs and proposed orders be extended to November 7, 2019. In support of their motion, Movants stated that conflicting obligations have interfered with the completion of briefs and proposed orders, and that additional time would allow the parties to complete the preparation of their briefs and proposed orders. Finally, Movants stated that they have conferred with counsel for all parties to this docket, and that no party has objected to the requested extension of time.


