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

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

Even though your chances of seeing a mama nesting are pretty much gone there is another component of the circle

A minimum of 72 hours after the main hatch Topsail Turtle Project volunteers gen

tly begin excavating the nest and removing the contents. So, what's likely to be in there after the main hatch? Shells of turtles that have successarter the main nation? Shells of turtles that have successfully hatched; unhatched eggs; live hatchlings (the ones that didn't hear the alarm and slept through the main hatch or had difficulty making their way out on their own) and sadly, deceased turtles. Contents are carefully separated and the process of collecting and recording data for the NC Wildlife Resources Commission begins. They count the number of hatched shells, which is different from the emerged number.
