ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE CHAIR: On May 26, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Reply Comments in the above-captioned docket. In summary, the Order set June 29, 2020, as the date for parties to file reply comments on the proposed rules for access to electric customer usage data filed by several parties in this docket.

On June 23, 2020, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the date for filing reply comments be extended to July 17, 2020. The Public Staff stated that additional time is needed to complete its investigation and discussion of the initial comments and proposed rules with other parties, and that the additional time may allow consensus to be reached on some of the outstanding issues, as well as provide more meaningful reply comments. Further, the Public Staff stated that it contacted all the parties to this proceeding about the requested extension of time and that Duke Energy Progress, LLC, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina, the North Carolina Attorney General, North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association, Mission: data Coalition, Natural Resources Defense Council, Sierra Club, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and the North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance have indicated that they do not oppose the motion.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for parties to file reply comments to July 17, 2020.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
