BY THE CHAIR: On September 23, 2019, the Commission held a hearing in the above-captioned dockets. On September 30, 2019, the transcript was filed in the docket. On October 2, 2019, the Commission issued a Notice of Due Date for Proposed Orders and/or Briefs confirming a due date of no later than November 1, 2019, for briefs and proposed orders to be filed.

On October 29, 2019, the Attorney General's Office (AGO) filed a motion requesting that the date for filing briefs and proposed orders be extended to November 8, 2019. In support of its motion, the AGO states that it has worked diligently to prepare the brief but requires additional time. The AGO indicates that the attorneys involved in the present case are involved in appellate briefing and general rate case preparation for other utility cases, as well as other ongoing utilities and consumer protection matters. The AGO indicated that the legal issues briefed in this case will be better informed after the Commission issues a decision in the Piedmont Natural Gas rate case. The AGO further states that the record in the case is long and complex and that late-filed exhibits were filed as recently as last week. In addition, the AGO states that all parties to the proceeding have been consulted and either consent or do not oppose this extension request.

Based upon the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to an extension of time to Wednesday, November 6, 2019. Therefore, the date for all parties to file briefs and proposed orders in this matter shall be, and is hereby, extended to on or before November 6, 2019.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
