## ) ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE CHAIR: On April 15, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Standard Rates and Contract Terms for Qualifying Facilities in this 2018 biennial avoided cost proceeding requiring Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP; together with DEC, Duke), to organize a virtual stakeholder process to address the addition of storage at existing qualifying facilities and to report the results of the stakeholder process to the Commission through an appropriate filing in this docket on or before September 1, 2020. To the extent the Public Staff does not agree with any of the recommendations in the report, the Commission directed the Public Staff to file a separate report setting forth its recommendations) and basis therefor on September 1, 2020.

On August 28, 2020, Duke and Dominion Energy North Carolina (jointly, Movants) filed a joint motion requesting an extension of time until September 16, 2020, for the Movants and the Public Staff to file their reports on the stakeholder process. Counsel for Movants indicate that they have contacted all parties and represent that no party has objected to the extension.

The Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time for the Movants and the Public Staff to file the required reports.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the deadline for Movants to file their report on the results of the stakeholder process and, if necessary, for the Public Staff to file its separate report and recommendations shall be extended to Wednesday, September 16, 2020.
