BY THE CHAIR: On April 27, 2020, the Commission issued its Order Granting Further Extensions of Time, extending the time for Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), (jointly, Duke) to file on or before May 15, 2020, Duke's queue reform proposal (Proposal) and a redline version of the North Carolina Interconnection Procedures, Forms and Agreements conforming to its Proposal. In the Order, the Commission also extended the deadline for comments on Duke's Proposal to June 15, 2020, and the deadline for reply comments to July 15, 2020.

On May 15, 2020, Duke filed its Proposal. On June 15, 2020, North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (NCCEBA), North Carolina Clean Energy Business Alliance (NCCEBA), GreenGo Energy US, Inc., and the Public Staff filed comments on the Proposal.

On July 8, 2020, Duke filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Comments on Queue Reform Proposal requesting the Commission provide an extension of time for all parties to file reply comments on Duke's Proposal. In support of its motion, Duke states that NCCEBA and NCSEA raised complex new issues in their June 15, 2020 comments. Duke requests additional time to further discuss these issues with the parties. Duke also notes that it had previously requested the Commission issue a decision on its Proposal by September 15, 2020. Duke states that it will modify this request as part of its future comments.

Duke states that NCCEBA and NCSEA support the motion and that no parties object to the motion.

In the April 27, 2020 Order Granting Further Extensions of Time order the Chair encouraged stakeholders to work toward consensus but noted the stakeholder process must draw to a close and the proposed revisions must be presented to the Commission for resolution. Notwithstanding the foregoing, after consideration of the record and in the interest of achieving consensus, the Chair finds good cause to grant this motion to extend

the time for parties in the docket to file reply comments to August 15, 2020. The Chair again encourages the parties to work together and strongly encourages the parties to reach consensus prior to the new and final deadline for filing reply comments.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
