BY THE CHAIR: On February 24, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Accepting Public Staff Stipulation in Part, Accepting CIGFUR Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues and Granting Partial Rate Increase (Rate Order) in the above-captioned dockets authorizing Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC or Company) to adjust its rates and charges for retail electric service in North Carolina.

On July 29, 2020, DENC filed a Notice of Appeal from the Rate Order.

On September 1, 2020, DENC filed a Motion for Extension of Time pursuant to Rules 18(f) and 27(c)(1) of the North Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure requesting that the Commission extend the time within which to serve the proposed record on appeal an additional 30 days from September 2, 2020 to October 1, 2020. In summary, DENC stated that due to other workload of the attorneys involved in the case, the complexity of the issues, the many parties, and the large record additional time is required to prepare and serve the proposed record. Further, DENC stated that it communicated with counsel for the Attorney General's Office, Public Staff, Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates I, and Nucor, who stated that they do not object to the requested extension.

Based on DENC's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED that DENC shall be, and is hereby, granted an extension of time until October 2, 2020, within which to serve the proposed record on appeal.
