ORDER ACCEPTING NOMINATIONS FOR NC GREENPOWER BOARD OF DIRECTORS

BY THE COMMISSION: By letter dated, November 2, 2016, NC GreenPower (NCGP) informed the Commission that a member of the Board of Directors, who represents consumer/environmental advocacy, will no longer participate on the Board due to a change in employment. That interested persons may nominate themselves or others to be considered for appointment to the NCGP Board of Directors by providing the following information for each candidate: (a) name and contact information, (b) the Board position sought, and (c) a brief statement of qualifications or résumé. Nominations must be signed and filed no later than December 16, 2016, in the Office of Chief Clerk of the North Carolina Utilities Commission by U.S. Mail at 4325 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, North Carolina 27699-4300 or by facsimile at (919) 733-7300; and

2. That NCGP shall take reasonable steps to provide notice to interested persons of this opportunity to serve on the Board of Directors and the process adopted herein.
