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Public Service Company of North Carolina, Incorporated d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (“PSNC”) and Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. (“Piedmont”) (PSNC and Piedmont collectively, “the LDCs”), through their undersigned attorneys, move the Commission pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-90 and Commission Rule R1-7 for an extension of the time for filing notice of appeal and exceptions to the Commission’s Order Requiring Implementation of Revised RNC Program and Renewal of Offer to Joint Market (the “Order”) issued in this docket on November 8, 2021.

In support thereof, the LDCs state the following:

1. Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-90(a), any party to a proceeding may appeal from a final order of the Commission within 30 days after the entry of such order, or within such time thereafter as may be fixed by the Commission, not to exceed 30 additional days.
2. The current deadline for filing a Notice of Appeal and exceptions from the Order pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-90(a) is December 8, 2021. The LDCs hereby request an additional 30 days to complete their review of the Order and develop exceptions to be included in a Notice of Appeal, to be filed on or before January 7, 2022.
3. The Order raises issues of first impression regarding the interpretation of the statutes and standards cited therein, and the LDCs request additional time so that so that they may fully evaluate the Order, its impact on their business operations, and assess their legal and business options.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth, the LDCs respectfully request that the Commission extend the time to file Notice of Appeal and exceptions up to and including January 7, 2022.

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

BY THE CHAIR:

On November 8, 2021, the Commission issued its Order Requiring Implementation of Revised RNC Program and Renewal of Offer to Joint Market ("Order") in this docket.

On December __, 2021, Public Service Company of North Carolina, Incorporated d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina ("PSNC") and Piedmont Natural Gas Company, Inc. ("Piedmont") (PSNC and Piedmont collectively, "the LDCs"), filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Notice of Appeal and Exceptions pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-90 and Commission Rule R1-7 seeking an extension of time to file notice of appeal and exceptions to the Order from December 8, 2021, to January 7, 2022.

In support of their motion, the LDCs state that the Order raises issues of first impression and that they need additional time to fully evaluate the Order, its impact on their business operations, and their legal and business options.

The Chair finds good cause to allow the extension of time as requested.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the LDCs shall have an extension of time up to and including January 7, 2022, to file notice of appeal and exceptions.
