NOW COME the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) and Virginia Electric Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina Power ("DENC" or "the Company") (together, "Movants"), by and through counsel and pursuant to Rules R1-7 and R1-9 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission"), and respectfully request the Commission enter an order granting an extension of time until July 26, 2019, for the filing of proposed orders by the electric utilities, Public Staff, and other intervenors on the 2018 integrated resource plans (IRPs) of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and the Company (collectively, "electric utilities").

In support of this motion, the Movants respectfully show the Commission the following:

- 1. On May 1, 2019, DENC filed its 2018 IRP and REPS Compliance Plan.
- 2. On September 5, 2018, DEP and DEC filed their 2018 IRPs and REPS Compliance Plans.

- 3. On December 7, 2018, the Virginia State Corporation Commission ("VSCC") issued an order directing the Company to file revisions to its 2018 Integrated Resource Plan by March 7, 2019. See Case No. PUR-2018-00065 (Dec. 7, 2018) ("VSCC 2018 IRP Order").
- 4. On December 14, 2018, the North Carolina Waste Awareness Reduction Network ("NC WARN") filed comments on the IRPs.
- 5. On January 22, 2019, the Company and the Public Staff filed a joint motion with the Commission requesting an extension of time to file comments on DENC's 2018 IRP, as the Company would be filing revisions to its 2018 IRP with the modifications directed by the VSCC in both North Carolina and Virginia. On January 24, 2019, the Commission granted this request and allowed interested parties 60 days to file comments from the date the Company submitted its revisions to its 2018 IRP, and the Company 60 days after the filing of initial comments to file reply comments.
- 6. On February 4, 2019, the Commission held a public witness hearing on the IRPs.
- 7. On March 7, 2019, the following parties filed comments on the IRPs of DEP and DEC: the Public Staff; the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association; the Attorney General; and the Southern Alliance of Clean Energy, the Sierra Club, and the Environmental Defense Fund, jointly.
 - 8. On the same day, DENC filed its revisions to its 2018 IRP.

- 9. On May 6, the Public Staff filed comments on DENC's IRP and REPS Compliance Plan.
- 10. On May 20, 2019, DEP and DEC, the Attorney General, and NC WARN filed reply comments on the comments on DEP and DEC's IRPs.
- 11. On June 12, 2019, the Commission issued an order requiring the electric utilities and the Public Staff to file proposed orders on the IRPs within 30 days of the date of the Order, July 12, 2019. It also requested that other parties wishing to file proposed orders do so within 30 days of the Order.
- 12. On July 5, 2019, DENC filed its reply comments to the comments of the Public Staff on its revised IRP.
- 13. For both the Public Staff and DENC, the attorneys and technical staff working on the IRP proposed order are the largely same personnel that are preparing for and will be participating in the avoided cost hearing in Docket No. E-100, Sub 158, set to begin Monday, July 15, 2019, and likely lasting for several days.
- 14. To allow the Movants time to prepare proposed orders that incorporate DENC's recent reply comments and adequately address the issues raised by the IRPs and comments of intervenors, the Movants request an extension of two weeks to July 26, 2019, for all parties to file proposed orders.
- 15. Movants have notified counsel for DEP and DEC of their intent to request an extension as proposed and he did not object to the extension.

Therefore, the Public Staff and Dominion Energy North Carolina move the Commission:

- For an extension of the deadline for the filing of proposed orders to
 July 26, 2019, and
- 2. For such further and other relief as the Commission may deem just and proper.
