BY THE CHAIR: On February 4, 2019, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket initiating a rulemaking on access to electric customer usage data. On June 13, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Second Extension of Time. The Order extended the date for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to July 29, 2019.

On July 22, 2019, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and the Public Staff (Movants), filed a joint motion requesting a further extension of time to September 12, 2019, for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules. In summary, Movants stated that they have been discussing a draft of proposed rules, but that they need additional time to continue their discussions, and that additional time may enable them to reach consensus on the outstanding issues. In addition, Movants stated that the Public Staff contacted all parties to this proceeding about the requested extension of time, and no party had an objection to the extension.

Based on Movants' motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to September 12, 2019.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
